
July 2022 compared with June 2022

Production in construction up by 0.3% in euro area and by 0.2% in EU

Up by 1.5% and 1.3% compared with July 2021

In July 2022 compared with June 2022, seasonally adjusted production in the construction sector increased by 0.3% in the **euro area** and by 0.2% in the **EU**, according to first estimates from **Eurostat, the statistical office of the European Union**. In June 2022, production in construction fell by 1.2% in the **euro area** and by 1.3% in the **EU**.

In July 2022 compared with July 2021, production in construction increased by 1.5% in the **euro area** and by 1.3% in the **EU**.



Monthly comparison by construction sector and by Member State

In the **euro area** in July 2022, compared with June 2022, building construction increased by 0.3%, while civil engineering decreased by 0.6%.

In the **EU**, building construction increased by 0.2%, while civil engineering decreased by 0.9%.

Among Member States for which data are available, the highest monthly increases in production in construction were recorded in **Spain** (+6.7%), **Hungary** (+5.7%) and **Slovakia** (+3.1%). The largest decreases were observed in **Austria** and **Slovenia** (both -4.2%), **Czechia** (-2.9%) and **Sweden** (-1.3%).

Annual comparison by construction sector and by Member State

In the **euro area** in July 2022, compared with July 2021, civil engineering increased by 1.7% and building construction by 1.4%.

In the **EU** civil engineering increased by 1.3% and building construction by 1.2%.

Among Member States for which data are available, the highest annual increases in production in construction were observed in **Slovenia** (+28.5%), **Romania** (+8.3%) and **Austria** (+7.6%). The largest decreases were recorded in **Sweden** (-8.7%), **Spain** (-5.2%) and **Czechia** (-2.7%).

Geographical information

The **euro area** (EA19) includes Belgium, Germany, Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Italy, Cyprus, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, the Netherlands, Austria, Portugal, Slovenia, Slovakia and Finland.

The **European Union** (EU27) includes Belgium, Bulgaria, Czechia, Denmark, Germany, Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Croatia, Italy, Cyprus, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Hungary, Malta, the Netherlands, Austria, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovenia, Slovakia, Finland and Sweden.

Estonia, Greece, Croatia, Cyprus, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg and Malta are not required to supply monthly data within 1 month and 15 days after the end of the reference month under Regulation (EU) 2019/2152. Ireland has a derogation to remain with quarterly frequency and Denmark to have a longer deadline until the end of 2023.

Methods and definitions

The **index of production in construction** approximates the evolution of the volume of production within the sector, broken down into building construction and civil engineering.

Seasonally adjusted euro area and EU series are calculated by aggregating the seasonally adjusted national data. Eurostat carries out the seasonal adjustment of the data for those countries that do not adjust their data for seasonal effects.

The monthly index as presented in this News Release is calculated only on the basis of the data of those countries reporting monthly data. Missing observations from Member States for recent months are estimated for the calculation of the euro area and the EU aggregates.

Revisions and timetable

Data of previous months have been revised compared with those issued in News Release [95/2022](#) of 18 August 2022. The monthly percentage change for June 2022 was revised from -1.3% to -1.2% in the euro area and from -1.2% to -1.3% in the EU. The annual percentage change has been revised from +0.1% to +1.3% in the euro area and from +0.6% to +1.3% in the EU.


August 2022 compared with July 2022

Production in construction down by 0.6% in euro area and by 0.4% in EU

Up by 2.3% and 2.8% compared with August 2021

In August 2022 compared with July 2022, seasonally adjusted production in the construction sector decreased by 0.6% in the **euro area** and by 0.4% in the **EU**, according to first estimates from **Eurostat, the statistical office of the European Union**. In July 2022, production in construction increased by 0.3% in the **euro area** and by 0.2% in the **EU**.

In August 2022 compared with August 2021, production in construction increased by 2.3% in the **euro area** and by 2.8% in the **EU**.



Monthly comparison by construction sector and by Member State

In the **euro area** in August 2022, compared with July 2022, civil engineering decreased by 1.4% and building construction by 0.4%.

In the **EU**, civil engineering decreased by 1.2% and building construction by 0.1%.

Among Member States for which data are available, the largest monthly decreases in production in construction were recorded in **Hungary** (-4.4%), the **Netherlands** (-3.7%) and **Germany** (-2.1%). The highest increases were observed in **Romania** (+2.5%), **Portugal** (+2.3%) and **Austria** (+2.0%).

Annual comparison by construction sector and by Member State

In the **euro area** in August 2022, compared with August 2021, building construction increased by 2.4% and civil engineering by 0.5%.

In the **EU** building construction increased by 3.1% and civil engineering by 0.5%.

Among Member States for which data are available, the highest annual increases in production in construction were observed in **Slovenia** (+30.2%), **Romania** (+15.8%) and **Austria** (+13.7%). Decreases were recorded in **Spain** (-5.6%), the **Netherlands** (-1.7%) and **Czechia** (-0.3%).

Geographical information

The **euro area** (EA19) includes Belgium, Germany, Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Italy, Cyprus, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, the Netherlands, Austria, Portugal, Slovenia, Slovakia and Finland.

The **European Union** (EU27) includes Belgium, Bulgaria, Czechia, Denmark, Germany, Estonia, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Croatia, Italy, Cyprus, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Hungary, Malta, the Netherlands, Austria, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovenia, Slovakia, Finland and Sweden.

Estonia, Greece, Croatia, Cyprus, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg and Malta are not required to supply monthly data within 1 month and 15 days after the end of the reference month under Regulation (EU) 2019/2152. Ireland has a derogation to remain with quarterly frequency and Denmark to have a longer deadline until the end of 2023.

Methods and definitions

The **index of production in construction** approximates the evolution of the volume of production within the sector, broken down into building construction and civil engineering.

Seasonally adjusted euro area and EU series are calculated by aggregating the seasonally adjusted national data. Eurostat carries out the seasonal adjustment of the data for those countries that do not adjust their data for seasonal effects.

The monthly index as presented in this News Release is calculated only on the basis of the data of those countries reporting monthly data. Missing observations from Member States for recent months are estimated for the calculation of the euro area and the EU aggregates.

Revisions and timetable

Data of previous months have been revised compared with those issued in News Release 106/2022 of 19 September 2022. The monthly percentage increases for July 2022 remained unchanged at +0.3% in the euro area and at +0.2% in the EU. The annual percentage change has been revised from +1.5% to +2.1% in the euro area and from +1.3% to +2.0% in the EU.
